1. There will be a weekly test for classes VI to XII and monthly test for classes I to V.
2. The assessment structure for classes I to VIII will be two Periodic Tests, Half Yearly and Annual Examination.
3. For Classes IX and X, XI and XII ,the assessment structure will be as per the new guidelines from CBSE which will be shared later.
4. The First Periodic test will be conducted in the month of July, Half yearly in the last week of September, Second Periodic test in January and Annual Examination in February- March. Please note that Pre-board exams will be conducted in the month of December.
5. Office will remain open from Morning 8.00 to 12.00 noon every day during summer vacation except on Sundays and holidays.
6. CBSE introduces Artificial Intelligence [Code 417], a Vocational Course under NSQF as a sixth additional subject for the students of class IX. The benefit of the scheme is, if any student fails in any one of the subjects (Maths, Science and Social Science) the marks of that particular subject will be replaced with the marks of this sixth additional subject and the result of class X Board examination will be computed accordingly.
7. ‘Personal Information’, page of Diary must be filled before 5<sup>th</sup> April 2024 along with Parent’s signature and passport size photos.
8. Days are fixed for Home Work in Classes VI to VIII. Home work of Maths will be given every day. Monday, Wednesday & Friday - Science and English, Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday – Hindi and Social Science.

9. **Birthdays will be celebrated only in the assembly. Students are not allowed to distribute any kind of sweet & eatables.**
  10. All notebooks and books to be covered and details of students to be filled.
  11. Separate Marks for Homework and notebook work is there which will be added in exams.
  12. If student fails to attempt any of his examinations, no re exam will be conducted.
  13. School does not interfere with **any transaction** related to auto service in terms of monthly charges and other things in the coming academic sessions. **Thus, school will not be responsible for Auto service.**
  14. **Bus facility once availed cannot be cancelled in an academic session.**
  15. Parents are advised to follow the Government rules and must not buy vehicles for under-age children even if they are pressurized by their wards to do so. Students are not allowed to come to school on two wheeler without License and Helmet.
  16. Students have to bring the almanac daily. If student is absent or wants leave ,the remark should be written by the Parents in diary with the signature.
  17. 80%attendance is compulsory for the students otherwise school holds the authority to not allow the student to sit in exam.
  18. It is compulsory for the students to complete the given academics projects on time .
  19. **Fourth Saturday of each month will be considered as BAGLESS Day for the students of Class I to V where Experiments, hands on learning, crafts and skill based education and activities will be conducted. Details will be shared later.**
  20. **After successful implementation of Club activities last year, this year also, club activities will be introduced in the month of April for Classes VI to IX .Details will be shared soon.**
  21. **Parents can meet the teachers on every last working day (Nursery – XII) from 10.30 AM to 11.30 AM.**
  22. Students have to come to school wearing school Id , proper school -uniform ,shoes and blazers. Students are expected to follow the hygienic rules and get the nails and haircuts on regular basis . Girls are asked to come in two plaits with red ribbons only.
